ORDINANCE NO. 70

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 10.401 - 10.404 ENTITLED
CURFEW ORDINANCE OF THE MILLINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES

THE VILLAGE OF MILLINGTON ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: SECTION 10.401, 10.402, 10.403 AND 10.404 OF
THE MILLINGTON VILLAGE CODE ARE HEREBY AMENDED AND REPLACED
BY THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 10.401: A MINOR UNDER THE AGE OF 17
(SEVENTEEN) YEARS SHALL NOT LOITER, IDLE, OR CONGREGATE IN OR
ON ANY PUBLIC STREET, HIGHWAY, ALLEY, OR PARK, BETWEEN THE
HOURS OF 11:00 (ELEVEN) P.M. AND 6:00 (SIX) A.M., IMMEDIATELY
FOLLOWING, EXCEPT WHERE THE MINOR IS ACCOMPANIED BY THE
PARENT OR GUARDIAN, OR AN ADULT DELEGATED BY THE PARENT OR
GUARDIAN TO ACCOMPANY THE MINOR, OR WHERE THE MINOR IS UPON
AN ERRAND OR OTHER LEGITIMATE BUSINESS DIRECTED BY HIS PARENT
OR GUARDIAN. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION SHALL BE
GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR.

SECTION 10.402: ANY PERSON OF THE AGE OF 17
(SEVENTEEN) YEARS OR OVER, ASSISTING, AIDING, ABETTING,
ALLOWING, PERMITTING, OR ENCOURAGING ANY MINOR UNDER THE AGE
OF 17 (SEVENTEEN) YEARS TO VIOLATE THE PROVISIONS OF THE
PRECEDING SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR.

SECTION 10.403: WHEN ANY MINOR IS FOUND TO
HAVE VIOLATED THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 10.401, A PRESUMPTION
SHALL ARISE THAT THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN HAVING THE CARE
AND CUSTODY OF THE MINOR, DID ASSIST, AID, ABET, ALLOW,
PERMIT, OR ENCOURAGE SAID MINOR TO VIOLATE THAT SECTION.

SECTION 2: THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE
30 (THIRTY) DAYS FROM THE DATE IT IS PUBLISHED IN A NEWSPAPER
IN GENERAL CIRCULATION WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF MILLINGTON WHICH
SHALL BE JULY 12, 1997.
