Sec 6-5. D. vii. 3. Allow slaughtering/butchering as long as it is indoors, kept private out of view of any pedestrians, passer-bys or neighbors.

Chief Cartner would like clarity on the enforcement, if permitted is revoked do they have 10 days to get rid of the chickens? This is a municipal civil infraction, what happens after civil infraction is issued? Get a court order?
